

Government adopts UN Convention against Corruption

Luanda, 22/02 - The Government of Angola has adopted the United Nations Convention against corruption and the African Union Convention on prevention and combat of corruption during a meeting of the Council of Ministers at the Presidential Palace, "Cidade Alta", in Luanda.

According to a communiqué distributed to the Press, the two international legal instruments were adopted with a view to empowering the institutions with regard to the prevention and combat of organized transnational crimes.

The aim, according to the Government, is to dismantle the existing links between corruption and other forms of criminality which affect economies and countries.
