

Government releases more than \$2 Million for Demining

Luanda, 03/24 – The Angolan Government has released about \$2.5 million this year to support the country's demining programme and purchase equipment, communication materials and set up 15 teams for the various provinces of the country.

The information was released Friday in Luanda by the Chairman of the Inter-sectoral National Commission on Demining and Humanitarian Assistance (CNIDAH), Santana André Pitra (Petroff), during the opening of the 7th ordinary plenary session of the body.

He also spoke of the need to reactivate the operative rooms in some provinces as important information gathering nucleus required for the intervention of various operators, institutions, donors, investors and agents assigned to prepare the electoral process.

According to him, about 75 percent of the country's territory is affected by landmines and 2.2 million citizens live permanently under the threat of explosive devices.
