

## Parliament approves adhesion to convention against corruption



Luanda, 05/23 - With 115 favourable votes, without opposition or abstention, the Members of Parliament on Tuesday approved the adhesion of Angola to the UN Convention against Corruption, which requires Member States to create mechanisms with a view to banning this practice.

In a plenary session, the parliamentarians recognised that corruption is a bad practice that endangers any society, and stressed the need for Governments to set up measures to fight it.

On the other hand, as a matter of prudence, the Parliament decided to submit to the Government the African Union Convention on Prevention and Combat against Corruption, in order to get better explanations.
