

Cabinda Peace Memorandum Signed



Luanda, 08/01 - The Memorandum of Understanding for Peace and Reconciliation in the northern province of Cabinda was signed on today at the Meeting Hall of the Municipal Administration of Namibe.

In the presence of Angola's Acting Head of State and President of the National Assembly, Roberto Victor de Almeida, the document was signed by the Territory Administration Minister, Virgílio de Fontes Pereira, in representation of the Government, whilst António Bento Bembe signed for the Cabinda Forum for Dialogue (FCD).

The Memorandum of Understanding foresees a special status for FCD in accordance to the Constitutional Law and other legislation in force in Angola, as a united and undivided Nation.

Analysts admit that the consolidation of peace and reconciliation in Cabinda opens a new era of brotherhood and political-military stability that will enable the reconstruction and development of this Northern region of Angola.
