NOTE VERBALE DATED 23 DECEMBER 1999 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION
OF BAHRAIN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE COMMITTEE

The Permanent Mission of the State of Bahrain to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) concerning Afghanistan, and has the honour to inform it that in accordance with resolution 1267 (1999) of 15 October 1999, the Government of Bahrain has taken the following steps:

- (a) Informed all the competent authorities in Bahrain not to allow any aircraft to take off or land in Bahrain if it is owned, leased or operated by or on behalf of the Taliban, including those owned, leased or operated by Ariana airline;
- (b) Informed all the competent authorities in Bahrain to take the necessary measures to implement paragraph 4 (b) of Security Council resolution 1267 (1999) concerning the freezing of funds and financial resources of the Taliban.
