

AMBASSADOR KANDA AWARDED GLOBAL AWARD

Mr Ken Kanda, Ghana's Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the United Nations has been awarded this year's global award for his contribution to Global Understanding and world Peace.

The prestigious award from the Global Awareness Society International (GASI), a worldwide think tank that seeks to promote awareness of the diversity of cultures with in the world was in recognition of Ambassador Kanda's promotion of Ghana at the United Nations and his excellent diplomatic career.

Dr Chang Shub Roh, founder and chairman of GASI presented the award at the 21st annual conference in New York. It was received on behalf of the Ambassador by Mr. William Awinador Kanyirige, Ghana's Deputy Permanent Representative to the UN. Scholarships and awards were also presented to students and distinguished members of GASI.

Earlier, Prof George Agbango, immediate past president of GASI said that the organization was committed to providing multiple forums for the exchange of research, knowledge and expertise on people oriented issues related to globalization.
