**STATEMENT BY MS. NOOR EMILIA ALIAS, REPRESENTATIVE OF MALAYSIA ON AGENDA ITEM 75: REPORT OF THE INTERNATIONAL LAW COMMISSION ON THE WORK OF ITS SIXTIETH SESSION ON THE TOPIC OF "RESPONSIBILITY OF INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS" AT THE SIXTH COMMITTEE OF THE 63<sup>RD</sup> SESSION OF THE UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY, NEW YORK, 29 OCTOBER 2008**

Mr. Chairman,

Malaysia thanks the International Law Commission (ILC) for the reports on the work of its 60<sup>th</sup> Session and on the work of Special Rapporteur, Mr. Giorgio Gaja on the topic of Responsibility of International Organizations.

2. Malaysia takes note that draft Articles 46 to 53 which deal with the invocation of the international responsibility of an international organization are intended to form one of the chapters in Part Three of the draft Articles dealing with implementation on the international responsibility of an international organization. We further note that this structure follows the model of the draft articles on Responsibility of States for internationally wrongful acts.

3. In this regard, Malaysia views that in general, this right to invoke can be considered taking into account the fact that the principles contained in articles on States Responsibility are also applied equally to international organizations.

4. As for the issues relating to countermeasures against international organizations, Malaysia wishes to reiterate our view that similar restrictions imposed on countermeasures as in articles on State Responsibility can be applied to international organizations. However, careful consideration needs to be made by ILC considering the special character of international organization as opposed to State.
