Transitional justice has become a critical component of efforts to strengthen the rule of law and an integral element of the peacebuilding agenda, through prosecutions, reparations, truth-seeking, and institutional reform. A transformative approach to transitional justice involves addressing not just the consequences of violations committed during the conflict, but the structural context of discrimination, which enabled these violations to occur both during and before the conflict. Employing this approach involves addressing the full range of rights violations women experience during conflict, and promoting women's access and active participation in the design and implementation of transitional justice mechanisms.

We hope to engage a broad range of experts, Member States, and civil society in a discussion that will focus on taking a transformative approach to transitional justice, in order to ensure that justice mechanisms address women's needs and priorities post-conflict.
